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ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

Broadspectrum Training Services offers the Custodial Specialisation of this qualification.

The Custodial specialisation covers the competencies required by staff members usually enrolled in an entry-level training program and required to demonstrate their capacity to assume custodial officer responsibilities. At the completion of this qualification, officers will be expected to assume full custodial duties.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

To be awarded a Certificate III in Correctional Practice, candidates will need to successfully complete sixteen (16) units of competency made up of five (5) core and eleven (11) elective units.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to confirm competence using a combination of knowledge based assessment and practical assessment during a face-to-face delivery period. After gaining some

work experience, final assessment will occur in the workplace, including evidence of work samples/document portfolio.

WHAT MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT DO I REQUIRE?

Students will be provided with access to an online Learner App where they can view and complete assessments and submit evidence. Access to a computer and internet connection is required. Workplace environment and opportunities for assessment will be provided by the student's employer.

COURSE OUTCOME

On successful completion of all assessments, a nationally recognised Qualification CSC30115 – Certificate III in Correctional Practice (Custodial) will be awarded. A Statement of Results will also be issued by Broadspectrum Training Services outlining the specific units of competency completed to form the qualification.

DURATION AND COMPLETION

Students have a period of 12 months from the date of enrolment to complete the requirements of the qualification.

Where candidates exit the qualification before full completion, they will be issued a Statement of Results showing individual units they have obtained.

VENUE AND DELIVERY METHOD

The delivery model for this qualification is flexible, but typically includes facilitated face-to-face, online and workplace components anywhere across Australia.
