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## ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

Candidates for this qualification will normally be employed in the supervision and management of offenders and detainees in the criminal justice system or within immigration detention centres, in Australian states and territories.

The emergency response specialisation covers the competencies required by staff responsible for responding to and supervising serious incidents or events that occur within custodial settings.

## QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

To be awarded a Certificate IV in Correctional Practice, candidates will need to successfully complete twelve (12) units of competency made up of four (4) core and eight (8) elective units.

### Core Units of Competency

- CSCSAS013 Manage conflict through negotiation

## ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to confirm competence using a combination of knowledge based assessment and practical assessment in the workplace, including evidence of work samples/document portfolio.

## WHAT MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT DO I REQUIRE?

Students will be provided with access to an online Learner App where they can view and complete assessments and submit evidence. Access to a computer and internet connection is required. Workplace environment and opportunities for assessment will be provided by the student's employer.

## COURSE OUTCOME

On successful completion of all assessments, a nationally recognised Qualification CSC40115 – Certificate IV in Correctional Practice (Emergency Response) will be awarded. A Statement of Results will also be issued by Broadspectrum Training Services outlining the specific units of competency completed to form the qualification.

## DURATION AND COMPLETION

Students have a period of 12 months from the date of enrolment to complete the requirements of the qualification.

Where candidates exit the qualification before full completion, they will be issued a Statement of Results showing individual units they have obtained.

## VENUE AND DELIVERY METHOD

The delivery model for this qualification is flexible, but typically includes self-paced study, workplace coaching and online components anywhere across Australia.
