ABOUT THIS COURSE

This course specifies the competency required to undertake safe working practices when responding to fire incidents in the initial stages. The competency is suited for employees who may be required to respond to a fire incident and use basic fire-fighting equipment.

PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites for this course.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

This course will cover the theory and practical functions to correctly identify different classes of fire and the methods and equipment used to extinguish them. The main topics that will be covered include:

- Understanding the principles of fire
- Raising the alarm and evacuation procedures
- Maintaining safety
- Select and operate basic fire-fighting equipment
- Identify different classes of fire
- Identify methods of extinguishment
- Determine first response requirements
- Evaluate response activities

ASSESSMENT

Participants will undertake a theory assessment and a practical assessment. The theory assessment assesses whether each participant has adequate underlying knowledge to successfully make an initial response to a fire. The practical assessment assesses whether each participant has the requisite skills to be deemed as competent in undertaking a first response to a fire.

WHAT MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT DO I REQUIRE?

- Participants must wear work clothing including long-sleeve shirts, long pants and steel-capped boots.
- Workbooks, study guides and other learning material will be included within the course.
