ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This qualification reflects the role of employees such as driller's assistants. It is aimed at people who work in junior roles within the minerals/hard rock drilling industry.

Candidates at this level perform a set range of tasks involving known routines and procedures. They work under supervision of a Driller, but have some responsibility for the quality of work.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

To be awarded a Certificate II in Drilling Operations, personnel will need to successfully complete twelve (12) units of competency made up of eight (8) core and four (4) elective units.

Core Units of Competency

- BSBWOR203 – Work effectively with others
- RIICOM201D – communicate in the workplace
- RIIENV201D – Identify and assess environmental and heritage concerns
- RIINHB201D – Load, secure and unload drilling equipment and materials
- RIINHB202D – Set up/pack up drill site
- RIINHB203D – Support drilling process
- RIIRIS201D – Conduct local risk control
- RIIWHS201D – Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedure

Elective Units of Competency

- RIINHB218D – Assist grouting or cementing operations
- RIINHB219D – Assist with air drilling
- RIIHAN206D – Transport plant, equipment and personnel
- BSBDIV301 – Work effectively with diversity

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to confirm competence using a combination of online knowledge based assessment, practical assessment in the workplace, and assessment of work samples/document portfolio.

WHAT MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT DO I REQUIRE?

Students will be provided with access to an online Learner App where they can view and complete assessments and submit evidence. Workplace environment and opportunities for assessment will be provided by the student's employer.

COURSE OUTCOME

On successful completion of all assessments, a nationally recognised Qualification RII20915 – Certificate II in Drilling Operations will be awarded. A Statement of Results will also be issued by Broadspectrum Training Services outlining the specific units of competency completed to form the qualification.

DURATION AND COMPLETION

Students have a period of 12 months from the date of enrolment to complete the requirements of the qualification.

Where candidates exit the qualification before full completion, they will be issued a Statement of Results showing individual units they have obtained.
