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ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This qualification reflects the role of employees such as derrickman, motorman, or operator on a well servicing rig. They perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications applied in a wide variety of contexts, which may involve application of some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

To be awarded a Certificate III in Well Servicing Operations personnel will need to successfully complete 14 units of competency made up of six core and eight elective units.

- MSAPMSUP172A – Identify and minimise environment hazards
- RIIWHS202D – Enter and work in confined spaces

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to confirm competence using a combination of knowledge based assessment, practical activities and assessments in the workplace.

COURSE OUTCOME
