ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This qualification reflects the role of employees such as senior drillers. It is aimed at people who work in supervisory roles within the minerals/hard rock drilling industry.

Candidates at this level perform tasks involving a broad range of varied activities most of which are complex and non-routine. They are responsible for the quantity and quality of the output of others and contribute to the development of technical solutions to non-routine problems.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

To be awarded a Certificate IV in Drilling Operations, personnel will need to successfully complete eleven (11) units of competency made up of six (6) core and five (5) elective units.

Core Units of Competency

- BSBMGT401 – Show leadership in the workplace
- BSBWHS401 – Implement and monitor WHS policies, procedures and programs to meet legislative requirements
- RIIBEF402D – Supervise on-site operations
- RIENV402D – Implement and monitor environmental policies
- RIINHB401D – Plan and supervise mobilization of equipment, crew and materials
- RIIRIS401D – Apply site risk management system

Elective Units of Competency

- RIINHB402D – Supervise mineral exploration drilling operations
- *RIINHB405E – Supervise water well drilling operations
- *RIINHB409D – Supervise mineral production and development drilling operations
- RIICOM301D – Communicate information
- RIQUA401D – Apply a quality management system on site
- RIIRIS402D – Carry out the risk management process

* Complete only one of these two units.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to confirm competence using a combination of online knowledge based assessment, practical assessment in the workplace, and assessment of work samples/document portfolio.

WHAT MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT DO I REQUIRE?

Students will be provided with access to an online Learner App where they can view and complete assessments and submit evidence.

Workplace environment and opportunities for assessment will be provided by the student's employer.

COURSE OUTCOME

On successful completion of all assessments, a nationally recognised Qualification RII40915 – Certificate IV in Drilling Operations will be awarded. A Statement of Results will also be issued by Broadspectrum Training Services outlining the specific units of competency completed to form the qualification.

DURATION AND COMPLETION

Students have a period of 12 months from the date of enrolment to complete the requirements of the qualification.

Where candidates exit the qualification before full completion, they will be issued a Statement of Results showing individual units they have obtained.
