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ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This qualification reflects the role of employees such as a driller or operator working in a well servicing context. They perform tasks involving a broad range of varied activities most of which are complex and non-routine. They are responsible for the quantity and quality of the output of others and contribute to the development of technical solutions to non-routine problems.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

To be awarded a Certificate IV in Well Servicing Operations personnel will need to successfully complete 14 units of competency made up of seven core and seven elective units.

Core Units of Competency

- BSbled401 – Develop teams and individuals
- RIiWHS405D – Maintain standard procedures and safe working practices
- RIiWSV401D – Rig up and rig down for well servicing
- RIiWSV403D – Participate in well servicing nipping-up and pressure test
- RIiOGD405D – Carry out well control and blow out prevention
- RIiRIS301D – Apply risk management processes
- RIiERR304D – Control emergencies and critical situations

Elective Units of Competency

- RIiWSV404D – Conduct fishing operations
- RIiERR401D – Apply and monitor surface operations emergency preparedness and response systems
- MSAPMPER300C – Issue Work Permits
- RIiSAM314D – Manage oil and gas drilling equipment maintenance
- RIiOGD305D – Apply blow out prevention operational procedures
- HLTAID003 – Provide First Aid
- RIiBEF401D – Manage non-routine, complex technical situations

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to confirm competence using a combination of knowledge based assessment, practical activities and assessments in the workplace.

Students will be provided with access to all learning resources. Suitable workplace assessment environments are to be provided by the student's employer.

COURSE OUTCOME
