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## ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This qualification reflects the role of a supervisor in a well servicing operation. The tasks performed by the supervisor in well servicing involve a high level of autonomy and require the application of significant judgement in planning and determining the selection of equipment/roles/techniques for themselves and others. They are required to demonstrate the application of a broad range of technical, managerial, coordination and planning skills.

## QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

To be awarded a Diploma of Well Servicing Operations, personnel will need to successfully complete 16 units of competency made up of ten core and six elective units.

### Core Units of Competency

- MSAPMPER300C – Issue work permits
- RIIBEF401D – Manage non-routine, complex technical situations
- RIENV501D – Implement and maintain environmental management plan
- RIERR504D – Manage major incident and emergencies
- RIIGOV501D – Identify, implement and maintain legal compliance requirements
- RIIOD502D – Plan and evaluate rig operations
- RIIRIS501D – Implement and maintain management system to control risk
- RIISV501D – Manage well servicing induction and orientation
- RIISV502D – Manage well completion and rig release
- RIISV503D – Manage and monitor rig up operations

### Elective Units of Competency

- RIISV401D – Rig up and rig down for well servicing
- RIIOD506D – Manage rig move and camp move
- RIISV404D – conduct fishing operations
- RIIOD405D – Carry out well control and blowout prevention
- HLTAID003 - Provide first aid
- TAEDEL301A – Provide work skill instruction

## ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to confirm competence using a combination of knowledge based assessment, practical activities and assessments in the workplace.

## WHAT MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT DO I REQUIRE?

Students will be provided with access to all learning resources. Suitable workplace assessment environments are to be provided by the student's employer.

## COURSE OUTCOME

On successful completion of all assessments, a nationally recognised Qualification in RII51015 Diploma of Well Servicing Operations will be awarded.
